

Canmore Community Garden 2017 Application Form

Please submit this completed form with payment by cheque in person at the AGM being held at the Program Room in the Canmore Library on Thursday March 23rd from 6:00 to 8:30, or mail to Canmore Community Gardening Society, c/o Anne Wilson, 810 3rd Street, Canmore T1W 2J7. Cheques may be made payable to Canmore Community Gardening.

Canmore Community Gardening Membership is required for all applicants.

- Individual - \$10 one-time fee.
- Family - \$20 one-time fee. (Includes up to 2 adults + unlimited kids under 16)

Please consider the 2 types of community gardening offered:

1) Allotment Garden Plot

- \$40/season for a 8' x 4' raised 'wicking bed'. There are 25 total of these available for rent. Plot Renters are able to renew their plots seasonally. The number of beds available each season will depend on how many returning gardeners there are. Gardeners maintain their beds autonomously within the organic community gardening guidelines.

- All Allotment Gardeners agree to contribute to Community Garden Maintenance by signing up for a task on the board in the Garden.

2) Communal Gardening

- \$40/season for participation in the communal garden beds. The communal gardens are intended to allow gardeners to share in both the responsibility and the bounty of the garden. First-time gardeners have an opportunity to work alongside those with more experience, and this arrangement allows flexibility for those who vacation or have limited time in the summer.

- Communal gardeners sign up for a 'Garden Team' and work collaboratively in the garden. Each gardener agrees to commit a minimum of 1-2 hrs/wk to the garden.

By signing below, I agree that I will:

1) Abide by the organic and wildlife-safe gardening guidelines of Canmore Community Gardening:

- * absolutely no chemical fertilizers, herbicides, pesticides!
- * on-site composting of garden waste only, in the community garden compost pile
- * no planting of berry bushes which are considered a significant bear attractant
- * timely harvest of garden bounty

2) Garden in such a manner as to build soil and increase fertility, increasing the diversity and resilience of the community garden ecosystem.

3) Be mindful of water use and strive to use this resource efficiently and sparingly.

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4) Behave in a responsible and respectful manner towards other gardeners.

(Allotment gardens are considered private, all garden maintenance and harvest intended for their respective owners only. Likewise, communal garden harvest is intended for communal gardeners only)

5) Consistently maintain and care for my garden, understanding that garden access is limited and if I am not able to commit to my garden, my plot may be passed along to another aspiring gardener.

6) Contribute to Community Garden Maintenance by signing up for a task on the Maintenance Board in the Garden.

I understand and agree that:

7) This Tenancy Agreement covers a time period between May 1, and November 15, 2017

8) I will clear and mulch my plot no later than October 31.

9) I will have right of first refusal on my plot year to year, provided I have abided by all of the above and continue to meet the eligibility requirements of Canmore Community Gardening.

10) If I fail to comply with the above conditions this contract may be considered void and/or my plot will not be reserved for next season.

11) Signing this agreement absolves Canmore Community Gardening from any liability, financial or otherwise, which may result from negligence or the inappropriate use of power and hand tools, either by me or by guests of mine.

*** All gardeners agree to participate in the Garden Opening and Garden Closing Work Parties at the beginning and end of the season.**

*** All gardeners are also expected to help with community garden maintenance by signing up for tasks on the Maintenance Board in the garden.**
